

Suggested Sources for Pre-Filled Formalin Jars

When formalin is used in bulk quantities and poured into smaller containers, there is a significant chance of exposure to this chemical above the permissible exposure limit (PEL.) Since formalin is listed as a human carcinogen, special care must be taken to avoid undue or hazardous exposure. OSHA's Formaldehyde Standard requires some very specific procedures for the veterinary practice, including monitoring of employee exposure and possibly respiratory protection plans. There is a provision of the Standard that exempts the employer from those testing and emergency procedures rules if the formaldehyde use in the workplace could not possibly expose employees above the PEL. If the practice procures formalin in extremely small quantities (e.g., enough pre-filled individual biopsy jars necessary for a month's operation), then there would be very limited potential of exposure from vapors or accidental spills and this "exemption" could apply. If the material is stored and used in an area with good general ventilation, then there normally wouldn't be a need for additional fume hoods or personal protective equipment.

Specimen containers pre-filled with formalin come in all shapes and sizes, so there is one to fit the needs of almost any practice. Many commercial diagnostic labs will provide these containers at no additional cost to the practice for using their service, so be sure to ask your lab before you buy them. Also, be sure to check with your regular distributor of medical supplies.
