

Suggested Sources for Mechanical Door Locks

There are many styles and sources available so be sure to check for local suppliers; look in the telephone directory under "Locks" or "Locksmiths."

This style is one that I've seen used in many veterinary practices with great success because it is very sturdy and durable. The mechanical style is usually better for most practices than the electronic style because they require no electricity or batteries. This same style lock is available with handles instead of knobs if desired.



There are also styles available for commercial glass doors (called narrow stile doors).
