## **Suggested Sources for Mercury Clean-up Kit**

When a mercury thermometer breaks, the liquid mercury should be collected to prevent evaporation into the room air and disposed of properly. In the veterinary practice, the best solution is to use a “mercury sponge” to absorb the liquid. The best style mercury sponges we’ve seen are these from Lab Safety Supply - called HG ABSORB JAR 6/PK. A single box of these sponge jars will last most practices many years.
